

About Johne's disease

Johne's disease causes considerable production losses within both dairy and beef herds. The clinical signs of scour and weight loss are well recognised. However, often the disease can exist unnoticed within a herd where culling rates are high as animals may be culled for repeated high Somatic Cell Count (SCC), mastitis, poor yields, infertility, or lameness long before clinical signs become evident.
